CRYSTAL PALACE F.C. MODERN SLAVERY STATEMENT

INTRODUCTION

This statement is made by CPFC Limited ("Crystal Palace F.C") on behalf of itself and its UK parent undertakings. Crystal Palace F.C. is a professional football club which plays its home matches at Selhurst Park, Holmesdale Road, London SE25 6PU. In the financial year ended 30 June 2016 Crystal Palace F.C. played in domestic competitions.

This Statement relates to the actions and activities during the financial year ended 30 June 2016 and the activities being undertaken to comply with the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the "MSA")

We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. We do not and will not tolerate modern slavery or human trafficking in our organisation or in our supply chain.

OUR POLICIES ON SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

We have implemented an Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy. Our Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in our business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to eradicate the risk of slavery and human trafficking not taking place in our supply chains. This policy operates alongside our current corporate policies and procedures which together promote an open environment within the organisation and support employees should any concerns be raised and set out how we expect our employees to behave at Crystal Palace F.C.

Our policies and procedures are periodically updated and we aim to enhance where needed as a result of the MSA.

OUR SUPPLY CHAINS

Crystal Palace F.C.'s supply chains for both goods and services are predominantly composed of UK based entities and many have long-standing relationships with Crystal Palace F.C. On occasion, Crystal Palace FC (and those in its supply chain) will source goods and services from overseas.

We want to work with suppliers that share our values and commitment to zero tolerance of slavery and human trafficking.

Due diligence:

We are looking further into our operations to identify any risk areas of slavery and human trafficking within our supply chain, to review our policies and procedures, and carry out due diligence to seek to ensure that there is no slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains.

TRAINING

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our business we are reviewing our training to employees and aim to provide MSA training to all applicable employees.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending 30 June 2016.
